NYC Department of Information Technology and Telecommunications (DOITT) 253 Broadway New York

> DOITT coordinates government IT policy & contracts for the entire city. In 2009 DOITT developed the NYC DataMine inspired by similar moves in San Fransico and Vancouver. The idea is to make local government data more accessible to applications Developers inevitably complained that it wasn't as open as they wanted, but DOITT have since updated their APIs and doubled the number of datasets. DOITT organises the NYC BigAppsIdeas contest, that encourages people to submit ideas for apps benefiting society, this has been well received and spawned 80 new NY-focused mobile applications at no cost to the city.
